About the branch

In 2008, AAUW of North Carolina established a new branch to serve the entire state. If you live near one of the communities noted on the map, please do check out the branch in your area. However, if you're based in one of the areas in between the current branches, or you have decided that participation in a community-based branch is not right for you at this time of your life, consider affiliating with the AAUW Tar Heel branch, a statewide, virtual branch.

What's different?

The branch has a very simple structure and complements the state structure in some of its functions.

We have no more than one formal meeting a year. Other ways to participate work with your schedule.

Local dues are kept low, joining the branch and state adds only \$16 to a national membership..

With a commitment similar to an at-large member of the national organization, members will have the additional satisfaction of supporting AAUW in North Carolina.
